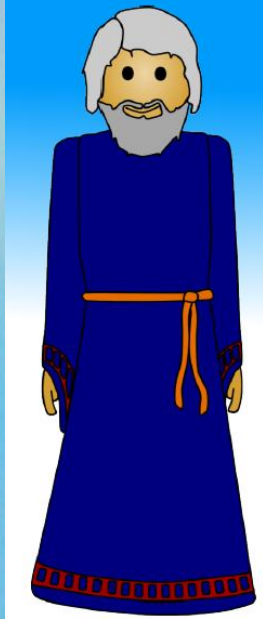
Luke 15:11-32

The younger one asked his father to give him part of his property (財物). The father gave him.

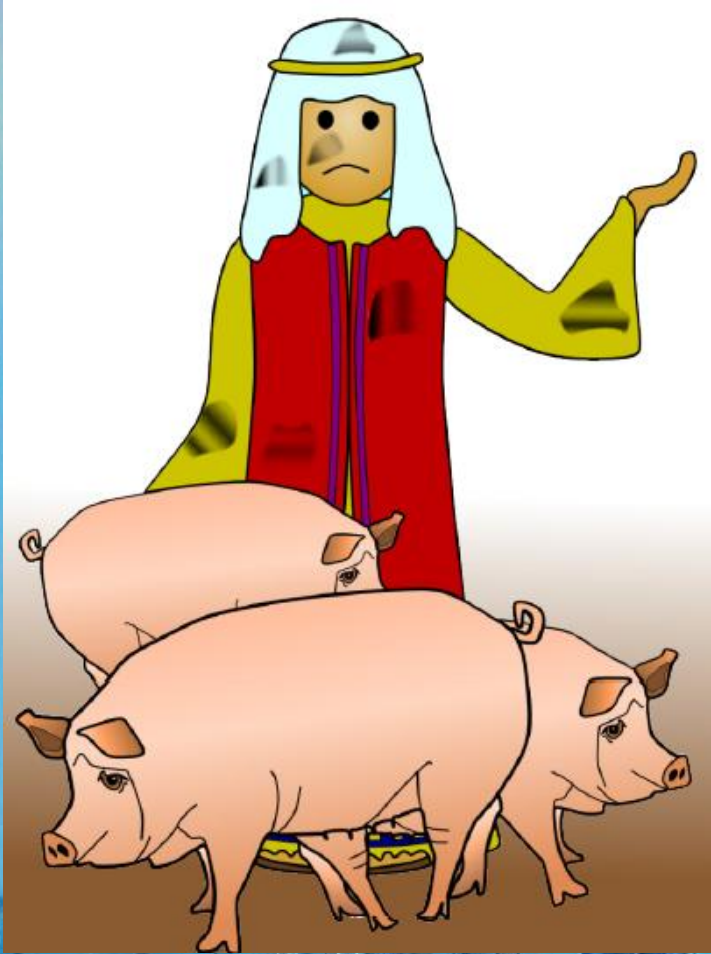
The Prodigal Son

The Prodigal Son



A famine (飢荒) came. The boy was so hungry that he got a job feeding pigs. No one feed him. He ate the pig's food.

He had an idea.

He would go home and
work as a servant for
his father.



He thought, ' I'll go
home and tell father
I'm sorry for my sins
(罪). I'm not worthy to
be his son anymore. I
hope he'll hire me as
a servant (工人).'

The Prodigal Son



His father saw
him from afar.

While the boy was
still a long way from
home, his father saw
him coming.



The Prodigal Son

He was overjoyed and they ran to each other...



Joyously the father ran to his returning son. He kissed the boy and hugged (擁抱) him.



The Prodigal Son



‘Father, I’ve sinned. I’m not worthy to be your son.’ The boy wanted to ask his father to hire him as a servant.

But the father stopped him and said, 'Bring the best robe, sandals and a ring for my son. And prepare for a great party.'
